# **SORG & NAPOLEON MADDOX**

LOUVERTURE (Album)

RELEASE: NOVEMBER 18th, 2022

The relentless Franco-American duo is back with its 2nd full length album "Louverture", inspired by the fight of Haitian General Toussaint Louverture. Rapper Napoleon Maddox has been combining his sharp flow on the productions of beatmaker Sorg for almost 10 years. Their 1st track "Wild West" (2013) was recently pitched by Netflix in the French series

"Braqueurs" (Ganglands). Their discography includes several EPs, a 1st album "Checkin Us" (2018), and numerous collaborations with renowned artists such as Gaël Faye, Hamid Drake, Marc Cary, Dobet Gnahoré, Cheick Tidiane Seck, etc. The activist and poet from Cincinnati (Ohio), Napoleon Maddox, leader of the group ISWHAT?! and member of the bands BadFat and Papanosh recently moved to France at Besançon, stronghold of producer Sorg, particularly noted for his remix of Rone "Wave".

This opus is about opening the doors of history, to explore and share the life of **Toussaint Louverture** around the worlds of jazz, electro and hiphop.

The revered Black Haitian fought in the French military and then against France to end slavery. For his stance against the continuation of slavery he was imprisoned in **Château de Joux** by Bonaparte in 1802. He was able to survive in the dungeon just a few months then died there in 1803. He remains an icon for freedom fighters, scholars studying liberation movements around the world, especially those concerned with the African diaspora.

The American born artist, whose real name is Napoleon Maddox, created Louverture de Toussaint during his artist residency in Besançon, supported and co-produced by the venues **La Rodia** and **Le Moloco**.

He chose to draw inspiration from the story of the Haitian general to create a quartet alongside Sorg, Canadian-Haitian multi-instrumentalist Jowee Omicil, and Malian pianist Cheick Tidiane Seck, who was eventually replaced by Franco-Haitian jazzman Carl-Henri Morisset. The premiere of this show took place at the Château de Joux under the bricked-up window of the cell where Louverture died. Sorg & Napoleon Maddox then decided to make an album, simply titled "Louverture", featuring the musicians Jowee Omicil, Carl-Henri Morisset or the rapper Marc Nammour of the french group La Canaille. The single and the eponymous clip "Louverture" filmed at the Château de Joux, a jazzy and soulful track, marks the beginning of the album. It's a journey through time, with atmospheric sounds, that echoes the story of this incredible freedom fighter.
